

- Please use the hand sanitiser on arrival
- There may be a one-way system in operation
- Only one adult per swimmer is permitted to attend. Any younger siblings must always remain sat with the adult .
- Swimmers must arrive 'Beach Ready' (in their swimwear) and have been to the toilet before arriving.
- Depending on the pool you swim at you may or may not be allowed onto poolside. Where parents are not allowed, the teacher will greet the children at the door to the pool.
- The teacher will register them and check they are 'fit and healthy to swim'.
- Parents are to wait in the designated area and are not permitted to wander around.
- Children should be dried off and wrapped in a towel / onesie / dressing gown / robe to leave.
- The use of changing rooms should be kept to a minimum and only used for nappy changes / toilets etc. Please ensure you use the hand sanitiser provided.
- We will operate a 'Track and Trace' system.

At the moment the current government guidance states the following key points:

- If a child shows symptoms of Covid-19 they should be sent home/not attend the lesson and acquire a test immediately, the remaining children in that class and the teacher can continue to swim.
- If the symptomatic child's test results are positive for Covid-19 that child should isolate for 14 days. All children and adults who have been in contact with that child within the last 48 hours should isolate for 14 days after finding out this information.
- If that symptomatic child's test results are negative that child should only return to lessons when they are symptom free and feeling better. The rest of that class and the teacher can continue to attend swimming lessons.
